DeGeeter endorsed by Parma Democratic Party

PARMA - Tim DeGeeter took another step forward in his bid to become Parma's next mayor when he secured the endorsement of the Parma Democratic Party on Thursday. DeGeeter will face three other candidates in the Democratic primary on May 3.

"I'm honored to receive this endorsement, and I think it shows that support is building for our campaign for mayor," DeGeeter said. "If elected, I'll fight every day for jobs and safe neighborhoods and fiscal responsibility at City Hall."

DeGeeter has spent the past seven years in the Ohio House, after serving five years as Parma's Ward Four councilman.
