Endorsements continue for DeGeeter

PARMA – Already carrying the official endorsement of the Parma Democratic Party and the high praise of city leaders, Tim DeGeeter has added the official support of Workers United Local 168-C, which represents the workers of Hugo Boss.

At a meeting held Tuesday, the Executive Board of Workers United Local 168-C (Hugo Boss) unanimously endorsed DeGeeter in his bid to be elected Mayor of Parma.
